29th Annual Smoky Mountain Quilters Show & Competition May 15–17, 2008 ENTRY GUIDELINES

CATEGORIES AND TECHNIQUES

- A. Bed Quilts — Suitable for use on a bed; smallest side minimum is 60 inches
 - 1. Pieced and Quilted
 - 2. Mixed Techniques or Appliquéd and Quilted
- B. Wall Quilts — Designed for wall display
 - 1. Pieced and Quilted
 - 2. Appliquéd and Quilted
 - 3. Mixed Techniques and Quilted
- C. Art Quilts — Three layers and quilted; designed for wall use
 - 1. Art Quilt, Small – Perimeter of 160 inches or less
 - 2. Art Quilt, Large – Perimeter exceeds 160 inches
- D. Pictorial — An art quilt that illustrates a recognizable image (such as wildlife, floral, landscape, etc.)
- E. Miniature — Contains the design elements and techniques of a full size quilt, but is scaled to miniature proportions. Not to exceed 24 inches per side.
- F. Kids — Quilt made for use on a child's bed.
- G. Other — Quilt entries that do not fit into above categories including: yo-yo, cathedral window, crazy quilts (tied), block-of-the-month, and kit quilts.
- H. Clothing — Patchwork or appliqué techniques, with or without quilting.
- I. Junior — Quilt made entirely by a child, age 16 or younger; not judged, participation ribbon only.
- J. Group — Quilt made by members of a creative team of three or more quilters.
- K. Two Person — Two quilters worked on the quilt; includes quilting for hire.
- L. Theme — This year's theme is "Going Green." Interpret as you wish. Width: 30 to 60 inches. Length: 30 to 60 inches.

RULES

- ♦ Entries must be quilted unless otherwise specified.
- ♦ Quilt is defined as three layers: top (fabric), batting and backing (fabric).
- ♦ Entry must be completely constructed and quilted by the individual on the entry form except for quilts entered in Group, Two Person or Other.
- ♦ All persons who worked on the quilt must be listed on the entry form (design, construction, quilting, etc.) If not an original design, credit must be given.
- ♦ All entries must hang for the duration of the show and may not be removed for any reason prior to designated pick up time.
- ♦ No special hanging requirements and no rigid framing allowed; quilts may be folded during handling.
- ♦ SMQ reserves the right to reject, recategorize or not display inappropriate entries (soiled, damaged, misrepresented, unqualified, etc.)
- ♦ The judge will have the final say in disputes involving categories and reserves the right to not award all of the ribbons/prizes.
- ♦ Quilts must have been completed in the last five years.
- ♦ Previous entries in SMQ shows are not allowed.
- ♦ Quilts without proper labels and sleeves will not be accepted.
- ♦ Entries are limited to maximum of five entries per entrant: one per category; three per individual; one per group; and one per person in the two person category (group and two person based on ownership of the quilt.)

Quilts will be judged for overall appearance, construction techniques, color, design and quilting stitch. Ribbons will be given to all winners, and cash prizes will be awarded to Best of Show – Bed Quilt, Best of Show – Wall Quilt, and First, Second and Third place winners in each category. A variety of special awards will also be given. Your quilt's safety and security are important to us. The quilts will be shown at Pellissippi State Community College, and 24-hour security will be provided. White gloved hosts and hostesses will be on hand during viewing hours.
