Class Description

EQ6 Sampler is an introductory class in which students explore the program's powerful design tools by analyzing and drawing blocks, experimenting with color tools, planning a quilt layout, and adding applique motifs and quilting stencils on layers. Students also experiment with other layout styles, export images, create a quilt label, and explore EQ6's extensive printing options.
