Workshop: ShadowPlay

When: Wednesday, September 17, 2008, 9 a.m. – 3:30 p.m.

In this workshop, students will learn how to create a sense of depth on a quilt by designing a wreath of leaves that appears to float on the surface. This wonderful 3-dimensional illusion is created by discharging, or removing, the background fabric's dye, combined with hand or fused appliqué. Note: Students will be working with bleach. Cost: \$50 (\$35 plus \$15 fee for non-members).

Workshop: Introduction to Needle Felting

When: Wednesday, October 22, 2008, 9 a.m. – 3:30 p.m.

Needle felting is a fun, popular way to customize your projects – quilts, wearables and accessories – creating a unique surface that can be further embellished. Students will explore a variety of needle felting techniques with different fabrics, yarns and fibers, applying each to a base fabric using special techniques and felting tools. A multi-needle felting tool (about \$16) and felting needles are required, or students may use a felting machine/attachment. Additional optional materials kit is available (\$20), payable to instructor. Cost: \$50 (\$35 plus \$15 fee for non-members).
