Do you love to collect fabulous collections of pre-cuts?

These Cathedral Window quilts are made completely by machine and are true quilts with batting and backing fabric.

In this workshop we will look at how to make charming cathedral window quilts. We will learn the basic technique

for this fun block but also consider how to design your project with scale, finished size, and desired scrappiness. 3-hours.

These projects can also be made with Jelly Rolls (2.5" strips).

These Cathedral Window quilts are made completely by machine and are true quilts with batting and backing fabric.



Supply List for Cathedral Windows:

Half Day Workshop (4 blocks) - 14 -15, 5" Charms squares

- Alternatively, 5, 2.5" jelly roll strips
- 9" x 9" fabric for backing
- 2.5" x 44" strip for binding
- Thread for piecing
- Complementary thread for quilting
- Sewing Machine
- Bring Walking Foot or equivalent for quilting
- Basic Cutting Supplies (e.g., mat, rotary cutter, ruler)
- Basic Sewing Supplies (pins, fabric scissors)
- Iron and pad (shared in classroom or individual)

Graceful Trees Quilt Workshop

Basic Sewing, Sewing Machine and Rotary Cutting Supplies.

Please bring Walking & Free Motion Feet.

Fabric:

- 9 strips 2.5" x 13" strips of background fabric. Choose the same color family of varying values (e.g., black and whites, green, orange, or beige). Avoid busy or large scale prints.
- 1 fat quarter for backing
- 1 fat quarter of black or dark brown fabric. A little pattern in the fabric works well. It adds texture to look like bark. (I like Michael Miller's Onyx Fairy Frost)
- 1 fat quarter for binding

Other Supplies:

- 14" x 20" batting (I like a very thin loft - 100% cotton. (I like Quilter's Dream Cotton – Request)
- 1/4 yd. double sided fusible (I like Steam-a-Seam2 Lite)
- 14" x 20" medium weight stabilizer. NOT fusible (I like Pellon)

Threads:

- complementary thread for quilting the background (I like a variegated thread to match the color of the background)
- complementary thread for machine quilting the tree
- piecing thread

Miscellaneous:

- Classroom will need 1 ironing station for every 4 students
